Sunday, March 26, 2023 Jesus and The Crowds Jesus and the Crowds"

- 1. Jesus and the crowds go hand in hand
- 2. Mark 5.21 "When Jesus had crossed again in the boat to the other side, a great crowd gathered around him and he was by the sea."
- 3. Mark 2.13 "Jesus went out again beside the sea, the whole crowd gathered around him and he taught them.
- 4. Luke 7.11 "Soon afterward Jesus went to a town called Nain, and his disciples and a large crowd with him.
- 5. Mark 7.24 "From there Jesus set out and went away to the region of Tyre. He entered a home and did not want anyone to know he was there. Yet he could not escape notice."
- 6. Mark 3.32 "Then the mother of Jesus and his brothers came and standing outside they sent to him and called him. A crowd was sitting around him and they said to Jesus, Your mother and your brothers and sisters are outside asking for you. And Jesus replied who are my mother and my brothers? And looking at those who sat around him, he said, Here are my mother and my brothers. Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother.
- 7. Luke 6.19 "And all in the crowed came trying to touch him, for power came out from him and healed all of them."
- 8. Luke 5.15 "Now more than ever the word about Jesus spread abroad, many crowds would gather to hear him and to be cured of their diseases. But he would withdraw to deserted places and pray."
- 9. Matthew 8.1 "When Jesus had come down from the mountain great crowds followed him and there was a leper who came to him and knelt before him, saying, Lord, if you choose, you can make me clean."
- 10. Matthew 9.36 "When Jesus saw the crowds he was moved with compassion to the depths of his being, for they were bewildered and dejected, like sheep who have no shepherd"

- 11. Mark 8.01 "In those days when there was again a great crowd without anything to eat, he called his disciples and said to them, I have compassion for the crowd, because they have been with me now, for three days, and have nothing to eat. If I send them away hungry to their homes they will faint on the way and some of them have come from a great distance."
- 12. Luke 9.12 "The day was drawing to a close and the twelve came to Jesus and said, Send the crowd away so that they may go into the surrounding villages and countryside to lodge and get provisions for we are in a desert place. But Jesus said to them, You give them something to eat."
- 13. Matthew 9.6 "Jesus then said to the paralytic, stand up, take your bed, and go to your home. And the man stood up, and went to his home, When the crowds saw it, they were filled with awe and they glorified God who had given such authority to human beings"
- 14. Matthew 7.28 "Now when Jesus had finished saying these things the crowd were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority and not as their scribes."
- 15. Matthew 4.24ff "So his fame spread throughout all Syria and they brought to him all the sick, those who were afflicted with various diseases, and pains, demoniacs, and paralytics and he cured them. And great crowds followed him......"
- 16. Matthew 15.29 "After Jesus had left that place, he passed along the sea of Galilee and he went up the mountain where he sat down. Great crowds come to him bringing with them the lame, the maimed, the blind the mute and many others."
- 17. He taught with authority + He cared for the people +he was one of them! (compassion)
 - Matthew 9.36 "When Jesus saw the crowds he was moved with compassion to the depths of his being,
- 18. What he taught and his life were interconnected People could identify with Jesus
- 19. Mob mentality, herd mentality, pack mentality, group think, or crowd psychology the concept has many names. These all boil down to the same idea: Individuals are influenced by a larger group. Regardless of whether that group includes people in your class, your neighborhood, or an entire nation, you may experience mob mentality. the inclination that some humans have to be part of a large group, often neglecting their individual

feelings in the process, and adopting the behaviors and actions of the people around them.

- 20. A crowd good influence or bad influence "He runs around with a bad crowd"
- 21. Hosanna Palm Sunday
 Limited depth faith in him. A celebration of the moment.
- 22. Is it possible to follow Jesus for the wrong reason?

 Miracles Temptation of Jesus in the Desert
- 23. John 6.66 "Because of this many of his disciples turned back and No longer went about with him.
- 24. When things were going good we are with you Jesus When things get tough When he made his decision to go to Jerusalem -
- 25. Matthew 21.09 "The disciples went and did as Jesus had directed them, they brought the donkey and the colt and put their cloaks on them and he sat on them. A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road and others cut branches from the trees, and spread them on the road. The crowds that went ahead of him and followed were shouting, Hosanna, to the Son of David, Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest."
- 26. Mark 15.11 But the chief priests stirred up the crowd to have Pilate release Barabbas for them instead. Pilate spoke to them again, Then what do you want me to do with the man you call the King of the Jews. The crowd shouted back, Crucify him! Pilate asked them, Why, what evil has he done. But all the more they shouted Crucify him. So Pilate wishing to satisfy the crowd released Barabbas for them and after flogging Jesus, he handed him over to be crucified."



A Reading for Palm Sunday

As Jesus approached Bethphage and Bethany at the hill called the Mount of Olives, he sent two of his disciples, saying to them, "Go to the village ahead of you, and as you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, which no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here. If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' say, 'The Lord needs it."

Those who were sent ahead went and found it just as he had told them. As they were untying the colt, its owners asked them, "Why are you untying the colt?"

They replied, "The Lord needs it."

They brought it to Jesus, threw their cloaks on the colt and put Jesus on it. ³⁶ As he went along, people spread their cloaks on the road.

When he came near the place where the road goes down the Mount of Olives the whole crowd of disciples began joyfully to praise God in loud voices for all the miracles they had seen: Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord. Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Jesus, "Teacher, rebuke your disciples! I tell you Jesus replied if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out."
